To earn the B.Sc. IBA degree, students must complete:										
1. Students are required to study abroad prior to graduation, and must satisfy the minimum English proficiency level which as stipulated by the IBA department.										
2. Students can intern domestic or abroad after their applications are reviewed and approved by the school. Students interning domestic or abroad should understand that their enrolment is limited to 9 credits for that semester. Internships will only be considered on a case-by-case basis. Internship abroad can be counted as “International Studies”.
